# Gainsborough Pedal Car Grand Prix

### TEAM Rules

---

1. Entry Fee is £250. Full payment must be made to confirm entry to the race. All payments are non-returnable. Cheques made payable to "Rotary Club of Gainsborough" and posted to Julian Needham, Aegir Consumer Electronics, 39 – 41 Lea Road, Gainsborough, DN21 1LL.
2. All teams to be set up in the Pit Stop areas by 12.00 am. Due to fair set up and safety, no team will be admitted after this time. Practice circuits will be permitted from this time.
3. Ideally, teams should have a minimum of 10 members, age limit 16 years and over. Due to the physical exertion of each circuit the individual team members should not participate if they are (or think they are) pregnant, have high blood pressure, heart problems and or been advised by their doctor not to participate in such physical activity.
4. Helmets must be worn at all times while in the car.
5. For Health & Safety of all, St. John Ambulance/Lives will be on site. It is the responsibility of the individual to ensure their own safety and follow safe practice of not causing obstruction, litter, or any other activity which could cause harm. Any accidents should be reported to a steward.
6. All cars will be pedal powered only. Cars will be inspected to ensure that no gears, motors or any other means of propulsion have been added. Any breach will be disqualification. Judges decision is final.
7. No repairs of any sort (includes punctured tyres) can or will be made to the Pedal Cars on the race day. Minor adjustments will be made as necessary, but only by nominated members of the Rotary Club of Gainsborough.

8. Time trials will begin at 12.00 noon. This will consist of each team driving one circuit which will be time be the adjudicator. This will be the basis for your team's starting position. Adjudicator decision is final.
9. Inspection of cars will be at 12.00 noon. There will be a prize for the best turned out team (this includes your pit stop!)
10. Pit Stop area will be allocated to you by the stewards. This does not include gazebos, tents, seating which should be brought by your team. Any adornments (flags etc) must be set away from the track so as not to obstruct or distract drivers.
11. The organizers have the right to disqualify any team that is seen not to adhere to the rules.
